Region

San Rafael, Mendoza.

Vineyard

Semillón (9500 kg/ha, planted in 2001) from San Rafael, Mendoza.

Soil

Soil of alluvial origin composed of sand, stone and calcium carbonate, with low organic matter content. This farm is irrigated by the waters of the Atuel River, coming from the Andes Mountains.

Harvest

Handmade in 18 kg boxes. March 12, 2024

Elaboration

Selection of clusters in the winery. Direct pressing of whole clusters with minimal pressure. 75% of the must is fermented in stainless steel tanks, and 25% of the must in new French oak barrels where it remains for 6 months.

Production

1700 bottles.

Tasting notes

Golden yellow wine with greenish tones, its aromatic notes are reminiscent of stone fruits such as peach and apricot, you can also find notes of orange blossoms neatly combined with aromas and flavors of vanilla and spices, due to its passage through French oak.
